FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners.

After I moved into the Queen of All Saints rectory in August, 2019, it didn't take long for me to discover that this parish, like others where I served, would be full of reminders that I am a person blessed by God. In fact, here, all I had to do was walk downstairs from my quarters and into the front office to discover God's care for me, visibly and wonderfully present in the people who worked there - Mary Arconati, Rose Palmer and Jan Schroeder.

All of them so hospitable, so kind, so eager to help the new guy get adjusted to a new assignment. Beyond those blessings, in Mary and Rose there was the added treasure of longevity, for both of them had been working at QAS for decades. They knew so many people and were able to school me on much of the history of the parish. After all, by working in the rectory they had a front row seat.

This week, however, I - and we - say good-bye to Mary Arconati as she retires after 32 years of working here. It is a well-earned and well-deserved retirement. Mary, as many of you know, has been a gem. She answers the phone - and with that, lots of questions. She keeps track of the parish schedule, so you can imagine her expertise at juggling, that is, at scheduling so many requests for space. She keeps track of Mass intentions, the Sacramental records, the parish buzz books, and donations made to the parish. She edits this bulletin, often patiently waiting for me to turn in my weekly column. And while she's doing all this, she frequently has to answer the door, greeting each visitor in a friendly manner. What a blessing Mary has been to our parish.

Pope St. Leo the Great commented, "It is certain that the poor more easily achieve the blessing of humility than the rich. Gentleness goes with poverty, pride more commonly with riches. And yet, very many rich people do use their wealth for works of charity rather than as a means to puff their pride. This spirit counts as among its greatest profits what it spends in relieving distress and hardship in others." I would say that is true of Mary and so many others who work at this parish - who find their greatest profit not in cash or material riches, but in the humble joy of serving others.

Jesus in today's Gospel encourages a spirit of humility from those who would be his disciples. Blessed, he says, are the poor, the hungry, the weeping, and the hated. In other words, blessed are those who realize they're not going to find all they want in this world. Real blessings, real reward, will come in Heaven. So different from those who want it all now and are determined to get it, no matter how many people they have to step on to get it. You will have lots of good times and good stuff, Jesus assures them, as long as you live on earth. But after earthly life is over? Well, no, goodness does not await you, but you'll have plenty of time to be hungry and grieve and weep. Sadly Jesus says, "Woe to you."

St. Therese of Lisieux wrote: "Holiness is not in one exercise or another, it consists in a disposition of the heart, which renders us humble and little in the hands of God, conscious of our weakness but confident, even daringly confident, in God's fatherly goodness." Our parish was blessed for many years in that goodness present in Mary Arconati, and will continue to be so as she finds other ways to serve QAS.

May God bless Mary, and may God bless all of you.



Mission 31 for The Sluggers is tentatively scheduled a week past Easter, April 24-29 in Waverly, TN.

On August 26, 2021 Waverly was inundated with 17" of rain in 24 hours. Nearly 400 homes were totally destroyed or severely damaged, along with 20 fatalities of which 5 were children.





A few of The Slugger team will visit Waverly in February to review potential projects.
