God is always talking to us; we just need to pay more attention. When you hear God calling have the courage to walk through the door and say "Here I am Lord."

From our Pastor



Dear Parishioners,

Allow me, please, to follow up on the last week's column and on the homily I gave at three Masses last weekend. I mentioned a few statistics then regarding the need for the All Things New initiative. In my homily I told you we currently have forty priests serving in full-time ministry who are age 70 or older. I also mentioned that on any given Sunday in our archdiocese 66% of the pews are empty. That means that in some parts of St. Louis there may be 150 people attending

Mass in a church that fits 600 people. Meanwhile, less than two miles away there may be 125 people attending Mass in a similar church that holds 600 people. Do we need to have two Masses in two churches within two miles when Everybody could easily fit into one church? These are the types of questions that will be answered with the All Things New initiative.

Let me add some further statistics for you. Last Sunday's Post-Dispatch had an article about this initiative which included some numbers that had been made known to us clergy a few months ago. One is that we now have around 200 priests in active ministry serving 178 parishes. (This number of 200 does not include retired priests living and working in parishes, like Fr. Leach at St. Margaret Mary or Msgr. Simon at St. Gabriel). Statistics tell us that by 2030 the number of active priests will be 150. Still serving the same 178 parishes? By 2040 the number of actives will be 130. Still serving the same 178 parishes?

Another interesting statistic mentioned in the newspaper article: In a section of St. Charles County there are 30,000 Catholics. All these people are members of two parishes and each parish has three priests. Thus, six priests to serve 30,000 souls. In the southern half of St. Louis City there are also abut 30,000 Catholics. Yet these Catholics are served by 26 parishes with 31 priests. Is this a good distribution of our priests?

Another item. In our archdiocese about half of our Catholics belong to 27 parishes, the other half belong to 151 parishes. Distance, to be sure, accounts for that higher number of parishes; churches for obvious reasons are spaced further apart in the rural areas. It's also true, though, that many of our rural parishes were founded at a time when parishioners came to church riding in wagons pulled by horses, which of course, is not the case today. It's also true when considering our South City parishes that the ethnic parishes be handled in a special way, e.g. Resurrection For the Vietnamese, St. Joseph for the Croatians, and St. Agatha for the Poles. Their situation will warrant extra thought.

It's easy to look at such numbers and survey a bunch of statistics and cry out as Isaiah does in today's First Reading, "Woe is me, I am doomed." But the Lord reminds the prophet that he will not be alone, God will be faithful to him, God will give him the words to say. To prove that, the Lord had an angel touch Isaiah's lips with a burning charcoal. I'll bet that hurt! But, it is also cleansed Isaiah of wickedness and strengthened him for the task ahead. "Whom shall I send?" said God. Isaiah responded, "Here I am, send me."

Let us pray that our response to the All Things New initiative be the same. Whatever happens over the next year may hurt—and hurt a lot. But, the Lord will be with us, that's His promise. Let us be with God. Let us be ready to do God's work.

As I write this on a Tuesday morning, I don't know if our school was able to celebrate the entirety of Catholic Schools Week. Perhaps we had the snow days they were praying to have. Regardless, we can be proud of our school, its faculty and students. They are special people. So are you for supporting our Catholic school with your generosity and prayers.

May God bless all of you.
