

FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

Every Saturday morning seems to be the time to check out the latest fix-it list posted on the kitchen refrigerator door, which usually leads to a trip to the local hardware store. Once a do-it-yourselfer went into a hardware store and asked about a new saw for cutting firewood. The salesman took a chain saw from the shelf and told him it was the newest model, the best they had. It possessed the latest technology and was guaranteed to cut ten cords of wood a day. The customer thought that sounded great and gladly handed over cash to complete the purchase.

The next week the man returned looking somewhat exhausted. "Something is wrong with this saw," he complained. "I worked as hard as I could and only managed to cut three cords of wood all week. Heck, with my old saw I cut seven a day."

Confused, and embarrassed at the performance of a product he sold, the salesman suggested the chain saw be tried. "Let's go out back. I've got some wood we can cut." The two went to the woodpile and a log was selected. The salesman pulled the starter cord and the motor roared to life - Vrrrooomm! Startled, the customer jumped back, shouting, "What's that noise?"

The customer trying to saw wood without the power of the saw to help him is very much like the believer who attempts to live the Christian life without the empowerment of the Holy Spirit given to the Christian community.

St. Thomas discovered the loneliness and powerlessness found when one is separated from the community. While the others were rejoicing over the appearance of the resurrected Christ, Thomas was sulking in his doubt and stubbornly announcing that he would not believe in the Risen Jesus. Today's Gospel tells us that Jesus remedied that situation and Thomas humbly declared Jesus Lord and God. Christ is glad to hear such words from Thomas and then Jesus compliments us who have not seen, but believe.

The First Reading from the Acts of the Apostles beautifully informs us what happens when we are together, not isolated. The community were of one mind and heart. Consequently, they bore with great power - Vrrrooomm! - witness to the Resurrection. There was no needy person among them. Rather, all contributed. All Shared. All had everything they needed. The power of Christ reared to life in the community and nobody had to ask, "What was that?"

How wonderful it was to see many more people at Mass last weekend. The six Masses we had in December to celebrate the Birth of Christ brought about 800 people to church. Last week, the seven Masses we had to celebrate the Resurrection brought 1,400 people. It does my heart good to see more people in the pews.

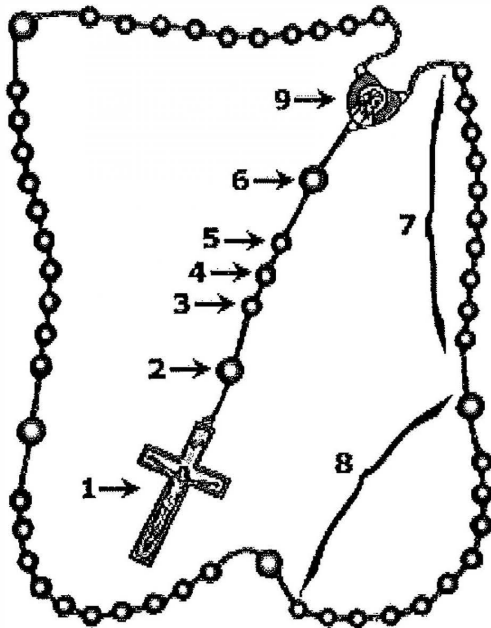
How blessed we all were to walk into a church so beautifully decorated for the Sacred Triduum of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, and the Easter Vigil, along with Easter Day by your fellow parishioners. I so much appreciate their design and effort. Certainly, their service enhances our praise of God.

Please keep in your prayers this week the second-graders of our parish. This Saturday, the 17th, over 60 of them will receive their First Holy Communion at one of the two Masses we have scheduled. Remember the excitement you had as your First Holy Communion Day approached? Remember how important you felt, how good you looked, and how close to Jesus you were? Our younger parishioners feel the same way. Pray for them. May they always hunger for the Bread of Life.

The Divine Mercy Chaplet



1. Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

2. Optional Opening Prayers

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty yourself out upon us.

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the heart of Jesus as a fountain of mercy for us, I trust in you!

Repeat three times

3. Our Father

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be thy name; thy kingdom come; thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil. Amen.

4. Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

5. Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; he descended into hell; on the third day he rose again from the dead; he ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from thence he shall come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and the life everlasting. Amen.

6. Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of your Dearly Beloved Son, our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

7. On the Ten Small Beads of Each Decade

For the sake of his sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

8. Repeat for the Remaining Decades

Say the "Eternal Father" on the "Our Father" bead and then ten "For the sake of his sorrowful Passion" on the following "Hail Mary" beads.

9. Holy God

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

Repeat three times

10. Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to your holy will, which is love and mercy itself.

Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, **you will need your User name and Password**. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
