If not, your priorities need to be readjusted. Don't let earthly things become a god before God. This is also the first commandment - I am the Lord your God, you shall not have any strange gods before me.

#### FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Fr. Mark Link, S.J. has written:

"Three days after Jesus' Crucifixion his distraught, defeated disciples were amazingly and inexplicably transformed. They set out ecstatically and courageously shouting to all the world, 'Jesus is Risen! Jesus is Risen!'

"Had they been deluded or dishonest about their claim, certainly one or more of the eleven would have confessed this under pressure of death. But none did."

Author Albert Cleath, in his book "Hope in the Midst of Horror," similarly comments:

"No reasonable explanation has ever been given to account for the transformation of their lives, except their own; they had seen Jesus alive."

It seems as if we are in the midst of a horror story as we celebrate the Resurrection of Jesus Christ. The pandemic continues, people keep getting sick, too many are dying. We remain for the most part stuck in our houses as more and more special events are canceled. Even here in the parish we have had to postpone two sacred Masses of the Easter Season, First Holy Communion and Confirmation. We continue to pray that Covid-19 be conquered and eliminated.

While we pray, though, we also talk. Talk like the Apostles did, talk about Jesus. The two authors quoted above are so right. If this were some conspiracy or a figment of someone's imagination or some delusional fantasy of one of the Eleven, someone would have cracked, one of them would have "spilled the beans." But none did, not once, not ever.

What Apostle would have said, "My fellow Apostle made up a story about Jesus being alive. It's all a ruse, but I don't want to be the one to admit he was lying so I'll let these guys skin me alive or burn me to death with hot oil." Who would ever die such a painful death to protect a lie?

No, this special day is not based on a lie or fantasy. It's based on the fulfillment of a promise of salvation. It's based on the obedience of Jesus Christ. It's based on the eyewitness account of the Apostles. Such a solid base has led to millions rejoicing in salvation and countless saints sharing in the triumph. Even today, surrounded by a virus, we offer praise and thanks to God. His Son Jesus has been vindicated and the gates of Heaven have been opened.

In the light of such a glorious victory, what are the problems we now face? Sure, we struggle with the way things now are. Yes, we wish things were different. We miss the opportunity to pray at Mass and gather with family. But we do not wallow in despair or give up hope. How can we? Christ has died, Christ is Risen. Christ will come again.

So, like the Apostles, we will be jostled about or shaken by world events. We may even face ridicule, threats, or martyrdom. We will trudge through frustration. But we will not change our story! Jesus has been raised and we will draw hope and faith through this Resurrection, now and at the hour of our death.

Fr. Philipp, Deacon Joe, Deacon Rich, and myself miss you very much and especially wish we could have seen you on this glorious day. It's not the same without you. Nevertheless, every one of you remain in our prayers. May the victory of the Risen Christ keep you unshakeable in your faith and constant in your confidence, for Christ has risen from the grave.

May God bless all of you. Happy Easter.





# STAYING AT HOME? GREAT TIME TO REGISTER FOR PREVENT AND PROTECT STL

## IMPORTANT NOTICE

#### NEW SAFE ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. EVERYONE (clergy, employees, and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system **ASAP**. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. However, in addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please read all instructions before beginning. Please allow about 1 hour of your time to complete ALL modules. (You may log in and out at your convenience, if desired.)




