FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

A very tired traveler came to the bank of a river. There was no bridge by which he could cross. It was winter, it was very cold, and the surface of the river was covered with ice. It was getting dark and he wanted to reach the other side while there was light enough to see. He debated with himself about the ice. Was it thick enough to hold him? Could it support his weight? What if he fell through, there was no one around to help?

Finally, after much hesitation, and with much fear, he began to make his way across the river. At first, he walked slowly, stopping after each step, listening for sounds of the ice cracking. Unsure of what he was hearing, he got down on his hands and knees and began to crawl across the ice. Still uncertain, he laid upon the ice on his stomach, very cautiously, and began to creep across the ice. He hoped that by distributing the weight of his body, the ice would be less apt to break under the load.

After he made his slow, painful, and freezing journey about halfway across the river, he suddenly heard the sound of singing behind him. Out of the dusk there came a four-horse wagon full of coal driven by a man singing merrily as he went his carefree way. Here was the traveler, fearfully inching his way on hands, knees, and stomach. And there, as if whisked along by the winter's wind, went the driver, his wagon, the horses, and all the coal over the same river!

Such a story may illustrate how so many of us go through life. Some stand on the banks of decisions unable to make up their minds about the course to take. Others stand on the banks trying to muster enough courage to cross over to the other side of the task or problem encountered. On the other hand, some individuals crawl and creep through life for fear of the thin ice. Their faith is not strong enough to hold them up. And then there are those who whisk along whistling and singing as they go. Their faith is unbreakable.

The triumph of the Resurrection puts us in the final group. Sin could be compared to the thin ice, unreliable and dangerous. Death is like falling through and being unable to get out, all one can do is struggle, sink, and die. Jesus' Resurrection frees us from such worry. Sin and death may lurk near us but they cannot conquer us. We can travel through life slowly, fearfully, crawling on hands and knees because we're so afraid, or we can remember the words Jesus repeated to his friends after he rose from the dead, "Be not afraid." We aren't. Not after being baptized into His death and resurrection. Not when we feast on Eucharistic food. Not when our Savior has promised to remain with us always. Some may crawl through life worried. We sail through happy and confident. Jesus Christ has been raised from the dead! Jesus Christ has saved us from sin and death!

I am grateful to our Liturgy Committee and the many people who helped prepare the beautiful liturgies of Holy Thursday, Good Friday, Holy Saturday and Easter Sunday, and to the people who helped decorate the church. Your service to our parish is amazing.

This is the first bulletin printed since our fantastic Parish Mission. Frs. Fonseca, Vien, Stanger, and Fallon were inspiring and the words allowed us to understand more deeply the greatness of Jesus Christ, to answer more convincingly the question of Jesus, "Who do you say that I am?" I'm thankful for all the work done by our Fiftieth Anniversary Committee to make that week a special time. Mark your calendars for our next big event, July 30th, when Archbishop Rozanski will visit us.

Lastly, a word of encouragement for you to donate to the Retirement Fund for Priests. It is comforting to know that the people of God care for those who have dedicated their lives to sharing the goodness of the Risen Christ.

MISSION 31--WAVERLY, TN APRIL 24-29

On August 22, 2021, Humphrey County, TN received 20" of rain in less than 24 hrs. The city of Waverly was hit the hardest with 15 adult and 5 child fatalities. Two who lost their lives were toddler twins.

Hundreds of homes were totally destroyed and hundreds more sustained major damage.

THE RECOVERY: Combined organizations have 155 homes scheduled for rebuild and 50 new homes to be constructed. The effort will take years and many volunteers.

Our QAS St. Louis Sluggers, a Ministry of St. Vincent de Paul, has 23 men and 2 women scheduled to work the reconstruction April 24-29.

We could use a few additional ladies and gentlemen with repair-rebuild skills. You need not be be a Master Journeyman to assist, the team will match skills to the task.

Every day of labor we commit to the rebuild brings a family closer to returning home.

This work is not about us, its about them--families that have lost nearly everything they have ever had, including a family member or friend.






