

#### SUNDAY OF DIVINE MERCY

The feast of Divine Mercy, or Divine Mercy Sunday, is observed on the octave of Easter. This year, the feast will be celebrated April 19.

The feast was promoted by St. Maria Faustina Kowalska, a Polish nun who kept a diary in the 1930s of Christ's private revelations, telling her of His message of mercy. She wrote that she first saw a vision of Jesus on February 22, 1931. He had rays of mercy streaming from His heart. Christ told her to have an image painted to represent the vision and to write below it, "Jesus, I trust in you!"

St. Faustina died of tuberculosis in 1938 at age 33. St. John Paul II canonized her in 2000 and declared Divine Mercy Sunday a worldwide feast day. Two years later, he granted a plenary indulgence for those who participate in the devotion. St. John Paul II was canonized on the feast of Divine Mercy in 2014.

"Jesus came and stood among them and said to them, 'Peace be with you.'" John 20:19

Are you good at making people feel welcome? When you meet someone new, like a new neighbor, a new work colleague, or a new parishioner, do you make them feel at home? Many of us can probably do a much better job at this. When we make people feel welcome we make them feel like they are included instead of being excluded. We are made for relationships - with God and each other. A simple "hello" and a smile goes a long way.

#### FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

There is a parable of a man in Hell who prayed earnestly to be released from his fiery torment. At last a voice said, "Rescue will come," and a carrot held by a slender thread was let down and the man was told to grasp it. He did so, and the seemingly thin thread began to draw him up. But others, seeing his ascent, seized upon his asbestos garments that they also might be rescued, and the man kicked them off, crying, "The thread will break," and break it did. Everybody tumbled back into Hell.

Again the voice spoke, "The thread was strong enough for both you and them, but it was not strong enough to save you alone."

The importance of being together is one Jewels gathered from today's Readings. While separated from the other Apostles Thomas has a mind full of doubts. He is alone with those doubts, a man aimless and joyless. When back with the others, though, Thomas encounters the Risen Christ. Doubts fade away, joy surfaces, and Thomas makes the stunning proclamation that Jesus is "my Lord and my God." Life and faith are so much better when experienced in community.

Our First Reading, too, emphasizes the community of faith. The Acts of the Apostles tells us "All who believed were together and had all things in common" and they took care of each person according to their need. This is an example of the community Christ calls us to be.

Unfortunately, this is not possible now. Yet I am encouraged when I hear stories of parishioners helping one another and when I see people throughout the day in our Church, there praying, I'm sure, for God's blessings on us all. I am uplifted when I see small groups of parishioners encircling their cars on our parking lot to talk to one another - always at a safe distance - and when I see a line of 20 cars use our lot as a staging point for a small parade of cars to honk their horns as they pass by the home of a girl celebrating her 13th birthday, as happened yesterday.

This past week has been glorious spiritually. Christ Is Risen!! Scripture, prayer, and Eucharist inspire me to praise and exalt my Savior. But it's also been a tough week. Our parishioners are still not here. We had to postpone First Communion and Confirmation. Our students will not be returning and Graduation has been postponed, also. The Parish Picnic has been cancelled. Yet through all of this so many people—in our parish, our country, and around the world—are not kicking people away but are doing the best they can to help others, to take care of others according to their needs. Faith in Jesus Christ Resurrected can cause that; such is the peace and spirit Christ brings to His Church, to us who proclaim Him, "My Lord and my God."

May God bless all of you.



#### How to Recite the Chaplet of Divine Mercy

The Chaplet of Mercy is recited using ordinary rosary beads of five decades. The Chaplet is preceded by two opening prayers from the Diary of Saint Faustina and followed by a closing prayer.



#### 1. Make the Sign of the Cross

In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen.

#### 2. Optional Opening Prayers

You expired, Jesus, but the source of life gushed forth for souls, and the ocean of mercy opened up for the whole world. O Fount of Life, unfathomable Divine Mercy, envelop the whole world and empty Yourself out upon us.

#### (Repeat three times)

O Blood and Water, which gushed forth from the Heart of Jesus as a fount of mercy for us, I trust in You!

#### 3. Our Father

Our Father, Who art in heaven, hallowed be Thy name; Thy kingdom come; Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven. Give us this day our daily bread; and forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us; and lead us not into temptation, but deliver us from evil, Amen.

#### 4. Hail Mary

Hail Mary, full of grace. The Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death, Amen.

#### 5. The Apostles' Creed

I believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth, and in Jesus Christ, His only Son, our Lord, who was conceived by the Holy Spirit, born of the Virgin Mary, suffered under Pontius Pilate, was crucified, died and was buried; He descended into hell; on the third day He rose again from the dead; He ascended into heaven, and is seated at the right hand of God the Father almighty; from there He will come to judge the living and the dead. I believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting. Amen.

#### 6. The Eternal Father

Eternal Father, I offer you the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Your Dearly Beloved Son, Our Lord, Jesus Christ, in atonement for our sins and those of the whole world.

#### 7. On the 10 Small Beads of Each Decade

For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

#### 8. Repeat for the remaining decades

Saying the "Eternal Father" (6) on the "Our Father" bead and then 10 "For the sake of His sorrowful Passion" (7) on the following "Hail Mary" beads.

#### 9. Conclude with Holy God (Repeat three times)

Holy God, Holy Mighty One, Holy Immortal One, have mercy on us and on the whole world.

#### 10. Optional Closing Prayer

Eternal God, in whom mercy is endless and the treasury of compassion — inexhaustible, look kindly upon us and increase Your mercy in us, that in difficult moments we might not despair nor become despondent, but with great confidence submit ourselves to Your holy will, which is Love and Mercy itself.





# IMPORTANT NOTICE

#### NEW SAFE ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. EVERYONE (clergy, employees, and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system **ASAP**. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. However, in addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please read all instructions before beginning. Please allow about 1 hour of your time to complete ALL modules. (You may log in and out at your convenience, if desired.)
