FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

The story is told of the newly installed pastor who decided one day to walk around the parish and acquaint himself with the people in the neighborhood. One of his first stops was at the local shoemaker's shop.

The pastor talked to the cobbler, using, at times, lofty theological language. The cobbler replied with keen understanding and a deep spiritual insight that left the pastor astonished. "You shouldn't be making shoes," stated the pastor. "A man with such understanding and a clear manner of expressing spiritual thoughts should not be doing such menial, secular work.

The cobbler was quick to reply, "Father, you better take that back now!" "Take back what?" asked the priest.

"Take back that I'm only doing menial, secular work," responded the cobbler. Now annoyed, the cobbler continued, "Do you see that pair of boots on the shelf? They belong to the son of the Widow McNamara, whose husband died last year. She's supported by her only child, who manages to keep a roof over their heads by working outdoors every day. I hear bad weather is in the forecast, and I felt the Lord saying to me, "Will you cobble Widow McNamara's boy some shoes so he won't catch cold and come down with a sickness?" "Certainly, Lord, I will," said I.

Looking at the priest, he went on, "Father, now you preach sermons under God's direction, I trust. And I will cobble that boy's boots under God's direction, too. Then, one day, when the final rewards are given out, the Harvest Master will say to you and to me the same approving pronouncement - 'Well done, my good and faithful servant.'"

Now, I doubt any new pastor at Queen of All Saints ever thought that Rose Palmer's job was one of menial labor. No, her work was far beyond that. As I mentioned when Rose's co-worker and friend Mary Arconati retired, the priests at this parish were incredibly blessed to have Mary and Rose working here. They seemed to know everybody and everything about this parish and their insights and advice were valuable to all who lived in our rectory - especially me.

Of course, Rose worked for this parish before it had a real rectory. She started working for Fr. Neuner when the rectory and parish office were in a neighborhood house in Tam O'Shanter way back in the 1970's. She started at the not-so-amazing rate of \$3.00 an hour. She was an asset to Fr. Neuner and all the priests that followed him, raised a family, lectured at Mass, organized the books, paid the bills, answered the doorbell and phone, prayed a lot and smiled always, even when someone like me came into the office and dumped more work on her desk. Though I never remember having any theological discussions with Rose, I understood quickly that I was working with a woman of deep faith, a woman who performed her tasks, menial though they may have appeared, under the direction of God.

The ancient Greek philosopher Plato said, "A little thing is a little thing, but faithfulness in a little thing becomes a great thing." Queen of All Saints Parish was blessed for decades with the great things Rose Palmer's faithfulness brought us. Let us pray for her and her family and wish her well in retirement. God Bless you, Rose!




