FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Like many of you, I received this past week an invitation to participate in the Annual Catholic Appeal of the Archdiocese. The theme of this year's Appeal is "Thy Will Be Done." The literature sent quoted Pope Francis, "We must live the faith, not only with our words, but with our actions." The Appeal allows each of us to do so in a way that allows thousands of people to be helped.

After prayerful reflection, I will determine the amount I'm going to contribute. Why wouldn't I want to donate? I am a beneficiary of this Appeal, for in the 1980's, as it does now, part of the collection helps run our seminary. I am thankful for the Annual Appeal helping me to get solid spiritual formation along with a good education. The Fourth Sunday of Easter is called Good Shepherd Sunday. Jesus proclaims himself a shepherd and assures us, the sheep, that he will take care of us always. Our good shepherd is no coward; our good shepherd won't run away.

One task of any shepherd is to lead the sheep to pastures where they can eat. It was the privilege of this shepherd to do that last week when I had the honor of feeding children for the first time with the Body and Blood of Christ. What are you planning to do for your mother?





Saint Mark, Evangelist Feast Day, April 25

Mark has a special place among the evangelists because he was the first person to write a gospel. Up until the time Mark wrote, there was no continuous written account

of the life, death, and resurrection of Jesus. So we can be grateful to Mark for his written gospel. Others followed his example, leaving us with four gospels altogether. However, Mark was the pioneer; he was the first to break this new ground. His gospel is the shortest of the four, but, nonetheless, it is a very powerful telling of the Jesus story. More than the other evangelists, Mark highlights that Jesus' preaching and living of the gospel challenged the status quo and brought great hostility down on his head, resulting in his crucifixion. Mark also emphasizes that being a disciple of this Jesus, living by his values, will often mean traveling the same way of the cross. Mark reminds us that living the gospel, following in the way of Jesus, is not easy; it makes demands on us; it stretches us. However, Mark also assures us that in our efforts to live the gospel, the Lord is with us to strengthen us and support us. As is said at the end of today's gospel reading, the disciples, 'going out, preached everywhere, the Lord working with them'.





With more than one location, please click the "This is my main/primary location" circle to indicate where you are employed or, if you are a volunteer, where most of your ministry or service is performed.

Agree to the Terms of Use and click SUBMIT.

You will then be prompted to <u>submit information for a background screening, register for a **Protecting God's Children workshop, view TWO ONLINE TRAINING MODULES and agree to the Code of Ethical Conduct. You have to complete ALL steps to complete the process.</u>

**If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, you will need your User name and Password. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
