Joe is a parishioner of Queen of All Saints and a graduate of our school. After the ordination Saturday Joe will return to the rectory, where he has been living during this crises, and he will preach the very first homily of his ministry at the 10:30 Mass on Sunday, the 3rd.

The new deacon is scheduled to be assigned to another parish this summer before returning to the seminary for his final year of study. God willing, Joe will be ordained a priest in May, 2021. Please keep him in your prayers.

The poem goes like this:

I would say most of our lives are more boring than they were six weeks ago, but we most definitely are not in control. Things in the country were going well and we could go about as we pleased. Not anymore.

However, the Resurrection assures us that Christ is the victor and from now on He will be in control. We get the back seat.

And from the back seat we may cry out and voice our frustrations, worries, and complaints, and Christ will look over His shoulder and say, "Pedal." So we pedal along through these difficult and different days, through this wild ride. Topsy-turvy though it may be, we believe, we pedal.

They weren't pedaling in today's Gospel, they were walking, and Jesus came to walk with them. The lives of the disciples, including these two on the road to Emmaus, had been disrupted on a major scale. Fear and confusion ruled over them. But this One walking along the road brought insight and comfort, patiently explaining the Scriptures. Once in the house more blessings came as Christ revealed His identity in the breaking of the bread. Their walk with Christ brought knowledge, their meal with Christ brought recognition and joy.

This same Jesus Christ remains with us today. Drawing near to Him will have our hearts burning. Prayer will bring us hope. And Christ still will be looking over His shoulder, saying, "Pedal."


LIVE VIDEO STREAMING MASS

STAYING AT HOME? GREAT TIME TO REGISTER FOR PREVENT AND PROTECT STL

NEW SAFE ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS

PLEASE NOTE

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. EVERYONE (clergy, employees, and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system **ASAP**. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. However, in addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please read all instructions before beginning. Please allow about 1 hour of your time to complete ALL modules. (You may log in and out at your convenience, if desired.)
