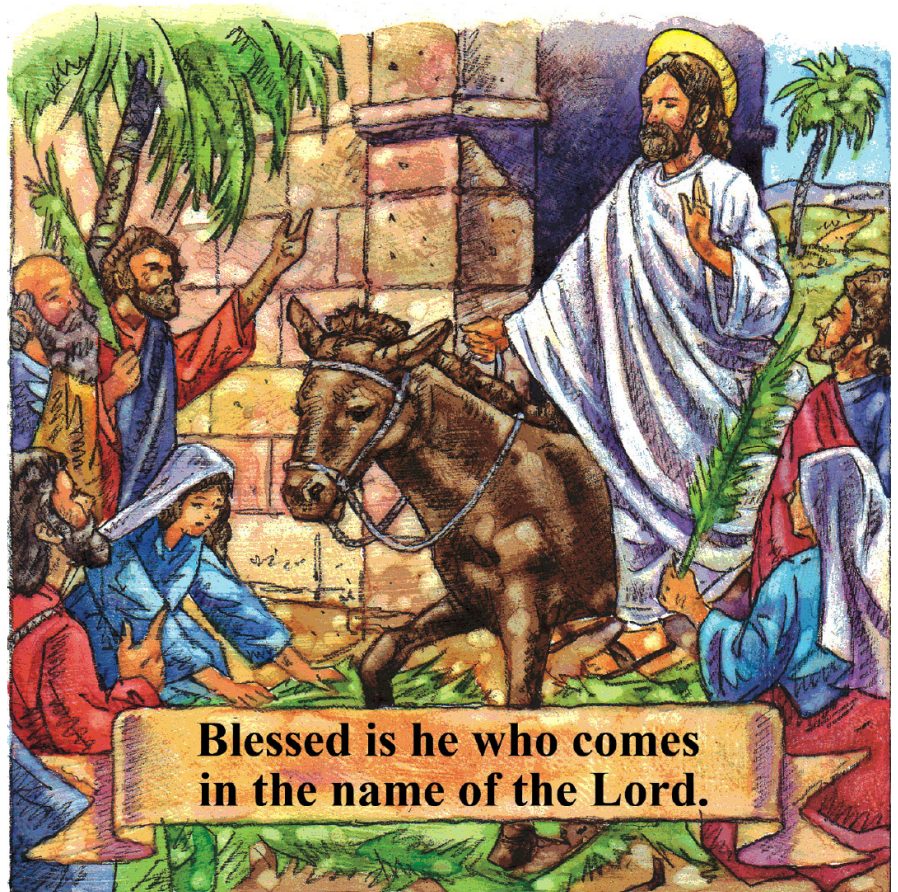

“Hosanna to the Son of David; blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord; hosanna in the highest” (Matthew 21:9).

With these words the Church enters the holiest of weeks, commemorating the passion, death, and resurrection of Christ. When the people of Jerusalem cried out with their “hosannas,” they were using an ancient Hebrew shout of acclamation that meant “Pray, save us.” The king to whom they were shouting eventually would save them, but in a way that would be far from what they expected.

Salvation would come from the wood of the cross as Jesus hung there to bring freedom from sin and life through death, opening the gates of heaven for all who put their faith and trust in him.

Many of us say that we believe in God. We go to church on Sunday. We volunteer for events at our parish. But when life gets hard, the pressure is on, when things aren't going our way, do we really believe, do we really put our trust in the Lord? When we live a life of gratitude, being thankful for the gifts we have been given, we really do see that God is providing all that we need. It opens our hearts to see God's active presence in our daily lives.

## FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

It's hard to have a Holy Week when chances to be holy have been curtailed. Yet that is what we must experience as this COVID-19 crisis continues. I know all of us had been praying and hoping that public celebrations of the Eucharist would be returned before Easter. Alas, the answer to our prayers was "No."

Now we look for other ways to embrace the goodness highlighted within these sacred days. Receiving the one sacrament available, Reconciliation, is a good start. We have confession this week from 9-10 a.m., Monday-Wednesday. We also added extra times on Tuesday and Wednesday from 6-7 p.m. Come and be embraced by the Lord's love and mercy. Please note that the Season of Lent ends Thursday so no confessions will be heard after Wednesday.

On Holy Thursday I invite you to watch the Mass of the Lord's Supper. While we will not have the drama of the Washing of the Feet or the splendor of the Procession of the Eucharist, we still will recall the Institution of the Eucharist and appreciate the gift of Christ's Body and Blood. After Mass, we will open the Church to allow you to pray before the tabernacle and assure the Lord that you hunger to receive Him.

Good Friday presents us the opportunity to recall the Lord's passion, particularly keen in 2020 as the whole world suffers from this pandemic. Christ embraced His cross with obedience and trusted in the Father's power. So, too, do we as we struggle to trust God in these arduous days.

Easter Sunday always brings light, hope, and joy. It will this year, too. Things will come through this difficulty, and all other difficulties and temptations, and we will encounter the Risen Christ. Not even death will frighten us for Christ has conquered death forever. His victory is our victory.

Today we hear the Passion of the Lord in the Gospel. Christ's determination to, first, enter Jerusalem, and, second, walk to Calvary, is inspiring. I recall the words of the spiritual author Anthony Padovano in his book "Who Is Christ":

"The suffering of the cross is not meant for itself but for something else. Christ does not suffer because suffering is in itself a value but because love without restraint requires suffering. We are saved not by the physical death of Jesus but by the absoluteness of a love that did not count death too high a price."

St. Francis de Sales put it this way, "Unhappy is death without the love of the Savior, unhappy is love without the death of the Savior."

Thus, despite all the mess in the world today, in this Holy Week we can be happy. Jesus Christ pays the price; it's not too high, for Jesus Christ loves us, He really loves us.

May God bless all of you.

## ARCHDIOCESAN GOOD FRIDAY REGULATIONS

**Good Friday (April 10, 2020)** is a day of **abstinence** (refraining from meat) for all Catholics **from age 14 onwards**. On this day, **fast**, as well as **abstinence**, is also obligatory for those **from the ages of 18-59**.

Abstinence means refraining from meat.

Fast means one full meal a day, with two smaller meals and nothing between meals (liquids are permitted).

No Catholic will lightly excuse himself or herself from this obligation.

**Those outside the age limits** and those whose state in life (e.g. pregnant women, manual laborers, those who are ill) may be excused from the requirements of fasting and abstinence, but are encouraged to take up some other form of penance or acts of charity or piety.

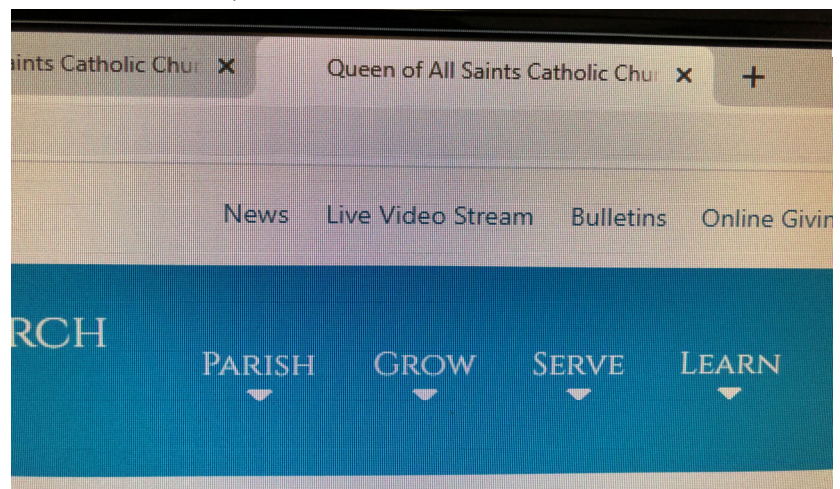

# IMPORTANT NOTICE

## NEW SAFE ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called **Prevent and Protect STL**. **EVERYONE** (clergy, employees, and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system **ASAP**. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. However, in addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please read all instructions before beginning. Please allow about 1 hour of your time to complete **ALL** modules. (You may log in and out at your convenience, if desired.)



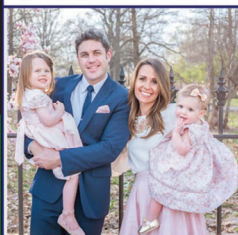
