How often do you actually say the words “I love you” to Jesus, to family members, or to friends? We are made to be in relationship with God and each other. Sincerely telling someone that you love them is the best gift you can give them because it comes from your heart. You are giving them the gift of yourself. We all crave love. Tell someone you love them everyday.

FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

There is a saying that some people see only the problem, while others only focus on the possibility. This saying brings to mind the words of a Trappist monk, Fr. Charles Cummings, "I live with a stronger hope for the possibilities that lie hidden within things, situations and persons."

This idea of hidden possibilities demonstrates how Jesus looks at people. He does not see only what a man or woman is, Jesus also focuses on what each person can yet become. He sees not only the present reality of each person's life, but also the hidden possibilities for the future.

The decisions of Jesus in choosing his apostles reflects his vision to see each person's potential. Jesus looked at Peter and saw in him not only a fisherman, but a man who had it in him to become the rock on which Jesus would build his church. Or, as in today's Gospel, Jesus saw in Peter one who would tend and feed the flock, one in whom Jesus could entrust His flock, people like you and me. Jesus sees each of us not just as we are but as we still can be. It's as if Jesus says to us, "Give your life to me and I will make you what you have in it to become."

A story about the great artist Michelangelo demonstrates the beauty of hidden possibilities. One day while sculpting in his studio, Michelangelo was interrupted while he was chipping away with his mallet and chisel on a huge, shapeless block of granite. The boy asked the sculptor what he was doing. Michelangelo asked, "Can't you see it?" Then he picked up the lad and stood him on the workbench. The artist continued, "There's an angel trapped in this rock. I'm chipping away all the pieces that are not the angel so I can set it free."

Jesus is the master craftsmen who sees and sets free the hidden possibilities in every man, woman, boy, girl, son, daughter, and Christian.

Jesus' expertise in recognizing hidden possibilities brought great dividends to our Church and our world. Peter, the one who three times denied knowing Jesus, now is prompted by Christ three times to affirm his love for Jesus. By doing so, Jesus can give to Peter a further task, "Feed my sheep." In today's First Reading Jesus' recognition again comes to the fore. The apostles, who had once scattered and abandoned Jesus, now have the courage and conviction to proclaim publicly the greatness of the Resurrection. Without hesitation they say to those authorities who try to silence them, "We are witnesses of these things" and "We must obey God rather than men." Who but Christ could see such potential in the Apostles?

That same Christ, that same Savior, peers into us and sees the possibilities. Christ's sight can go through our sins, past our worries, and around our fears, to the core of who we are - baptized into His Death and Resurrection and summoned as His disciples to proclaim the Gospel. That proclamation is something beautiful and it's waiting to get out of each one of us.

Please remember in your prayers the 8th graders and 2nd graders of our parish. Last Monday night the 8th graders received the Sacrament of Confirmation and yesterday the 2nd graders received their First Holy Communion. Pray for these younger parishioners. May the Body and Blood of Christ nourish them. May the Gifts of the Holy Spirit inspire them. May each one of them faithfully serve Jesus Christ and his Church.
