#### FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners.

Three people were discussing some recent translations of the Bible. One said, "I like the New American version. It is much clearer than the older versions and it is so much easier to read."

The second said, "I like the Jerusalem Bible. It's not only clearer, but it's more poetic, which makes it more suitable for me in prayer."

The third said, "I like my mother's translation best of all. She translated the Bible into actions, which makes it so much easier to apply to daily life."

Isn't it true that for so many of us our mothers were/are that perfect translation of the Word of God. In gentle ways, with enduring love, mothers throughout history have put flesh on the love of God. Imitating Jesus, they have guided their children toward the Kingdom. They have gone off, alone, to pray to the Father for those entrusted to their care. They have been ready to teach, to mold, and to forgive. In some cases, they were ready to give their lives so their children could live.

Imitating our Blessed Mother, moms accepted the gift from God, sometimes unexpected, of a child and put forth great love when raising children. Like Mary, they may have been confused over who their children would become, or the way they lived their lives, but they prayed with fervor and trust in God.

Jesus in today's Gospel says, "The Father who dwells in me is doing His works." On Mother's Day many of us can testify that our moms allowed the same thing; they opened their hearts in obedience to God and allowed God's wonderful love to embrace and uplift us - and so many mothers are still doing so today. Mothers may not have done so as perfectly as Jesus did nor as faithfully as the Blessed Mother did, but they loved and raised their children to the best of their ability. And today we pray in gratitude for them.

An unknown person said, "Mothers hold their children's hands for a while, but their hearts forever." May the hearts of children everywhere be filled with that amazing love, no matter how old we are or on what side of Heaven our mothers live. May we appreciate their translation of the Bible and apply it to our daily lives, joining together to praise God, follow Jesus, and imitate the faith of our Blessed Mother.

To all you mothers, mothers-to-be, and godmothers - Happy Mother's Day.





## STAYING AT HOME? GREAT TIME TO REGISTER FOR PREVENT AND PROTECT STL

NEW SAFE ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS



The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. EVERYONE (clergy, employees, and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system **ASAP**. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. However, in addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please read all instructions before beginning. Please allow about 1 hour of your time to complete ALL modules. (You may log in and out at your convenience, if desired.)
