

FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Corrie ten Boom was a member of an Amsterdam Christian family who used their home as a hiding place for Jews and resistance fighters during World War II. Betrayed in 1944, she was sent with a sister to a Nazi concentration camp. Her sister died there. After the war, Corrie became a messenger for mercy and forgiveness. Through her books and many travels, she crisscrossed the world preaching about Christ's love. She died in 1983.

One of the things she said was this: "I have a glove here in my hand. The glove cannot do anything by itself, but when my hand is in it, it can do many things. True, it is not the glove, but my hand in the glove that acts. We are gloves. It is the Holy Spirit in us which is the hand, who does the job. We have to make room for the hand so that every finger is filled."

The question on Pentecost is not whether God is blessing our own plans and programs but whether we are open to the great opportunities to which the Holy Spirit calls us.

Once the Lord said to a faithful preacher, "You have been working for me with utmost sincerity for seven years. All that time I have been waiting for the moment I could start to work through you."

The Apostles waited ten days after the Ascension for the Holy Spirit to come and work through them. And work the Spirit did! Immediately, the Apostles brought forth the fruits of that work - the Gospel was proclaimed, many stepped forward to be baptized, the sick were healed and sinners were forgiven, and missionaries began to travel throughout the known world. The Holy Spirit was handed down to successive generations and nothing could stop the Spirit's work, not hunger, persecution, nor death. Wonderful blessings occurred as Christians in every century made room in their gloves.

Today, on this Feast of Pentecost, it's our turn. Are we working, through prayer and sacrifice, to make room in our glove? Is the Holy Spirit allowed to fill every finger? This hand that is the Spirit is ready to put the glove - us - to work, and work hard. Our world needs to hear Good News. Oakville needs to share in the love, mercy, and victory of Christ. We need to bring that to them. Then, the strong driving wind of the Spirit filled the house where the Apostles were. Now, may the Spirit fill the glove we hold up, so that all may hear and know of the mighty acts of God.

The number of worshippers at Mass last weekend was smaller than I anticipated. Nevertheless, it was wonderful to offer Mass with a congregation present, to join together as a family in praise of Almighty God. As time passes and as the danger from this virus subsides, I know that many more of you will be returning. I look forward to seeing you. In the meantime, let us pray for one another.

May God bless all of you.

STAYING AT HOME? GREAT TIME TO REGISTER FOR PREVENT AND PROTECT STL

NEW SAFE ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS

PLEASE NOTE

Due to the pandemic, the Archdiocesan Office has started offering a Zoom Live Session of the original, mandatory Protecting God's Children Workshop to first time people while the stay-athome and social distancing orders are in place. They will continue to add Zoom classes as needed. This is yet another reason to register now in the new system, Prevent and Protect STL, while you may have some time on your hands. If you need assistance, feel free to call me at home at 314-221-3352 or email me at schroederj@qasstl.org.

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. EVERYONE (clergy, employees, and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system **ASAP**. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. However, in addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please read all instructions before beginning. Please allow about 1 hour of your time to complete ALL modules. (You may log in and out at your convenience, if desired.)

these restrictions are lifted we will resume Adoration.


