Dear Parishioners,

Two juvenile delinquents stood at a certain corner, hiding themselves behind the edge of a building, waiting for a certain man. They'd been watching this guy for a few days now, noticing his routine. He hopped off a bus each evening at 6:30, stopped at the store to purchase a newspaper and some snacks, and then walked home. His routine the youngsters had memorized, along with the size of the fat wallet noticeably stuck in his back pocket.

It seemed obvious to the young hoodlums that the older man was loaded with cash and they planned to mug him and grab all that money for themselves.

They made their move one evening, jumping the man from behind, punching and kicking him until the man fell helplessly to the ground. They grabbed his snacks and stole his wallet and ran for cover. Once in a safe spot they congratulated themselves on this success of their evil caper. Excitedly, they tore open the bulging wallet, but their joy soon turned to disappointment. The wallet contained only two dollars - and two long foldouts of picture after picture of the man's children.

It had been said that a father is someone who carries pictures where his money used to be. I know it was that way for my father, perhaps for your father, too, or yourself. The Gospel today assures us our heavenly Father knows all about us - what we've done, what we need, even the number of hairs on our head. Our Father is generous, merciful and loving, and with great confidence we pray to God each day.

On this Father's Day we pray for our earthly fathers, too, those here with us and those who have been called to the Kingdom. May God's blessing for them be bountiful and eternal.

God our Father,

In your wisdom and love you made all things,

Bless these men, may they be strengthened as Christian fathers.

Let the example of their faith and love shine forth.

Grant that their sons and daughters may honor them always with a spirit of profound respect.

Grant this through Christ our Lord.

#### **CONFESSION SCHEDULE**





# STAYING AT HOME? GREAT TIME TO REGISTER FOR PREVENT AND PROTECT STL

NEW SAFE ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS

### **PLEASE NOTE**

Due to the pandemic, the Archdiocesan Office has started offering a Zoom Live Session of the original, mandatory Protecting God's Children Workshop to first time people while the stay-athome and social distancing orders are in place. They will continue to add Zoom classes as needed. This is yet another reason to register now in the new system, Prevent and Protect STL, while you may have some time on your hands. If you need assistance, feel free to call me at home at 314-221-3352 or email me at schroederj@qasstl.org.

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. **EVERYONE** (clergy, employees, and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system **ASAP**. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. However, in addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please read all instructions before beginning. Please allow about 1 hour of your time to complete ALL modules. (You may log in and out at your convenience, if desired.)

### ADORATION IS A TIME TO CONCENTRATE SOLELY ON THE PRESENCE OF JESUS

One story told about St. John Vianney, the saintly pastor of Ars in France, concerns a farmer who sat in the back of the parish church. The saint noticed that the farmer spent long periods of time there before the Eucharist. Finally one day, the saint asked him what he did during his time of adoration. The farmer simply responded, "I look at Him and He looks at me."

This is what Eucharistic Adoration is: a time for us to concentrate exclusively on Jesus present before us and allow Him to look back upon us with love.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is a natural development from the celebration of the Eucharist. To receive the Eucharist at Holy Mass is an act of adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. Adoring the Blessed Sacrament outside of these times makes the times we receive Communion more spiritually mature, impacts us more deeply and allows us to experience a fuller communion with the Lord and others in our life (Pope Benedict XVI, "Sacramentu Caritatis," #66). No wonder the Church encourages us to take time weekly for Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament.

Once in adoration, one may pray in many different ways:

- Prayerfully meditating on the Bible or another spiritual book
- Praying the Rosary or another devotion
- Praying using a prayer book or a set of prayers as part of a Holy Hour
- Journaling in a prayer journal
- Quietly listening to a recorded talk or spiritual music on headphones
- Spending quiet time with the Lord

There is no one way that is more correct to spend the time in adoration than another. Be flexible to what the Lord wants you to do in the time of adoration. For example, you may want to read the Bible, but when entering the adoration chapel, Jesus pulls you into silent prayer. Allow Jesus to direct the time. This will help your time in adoration to be some of the best time you will have all week.


