

FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

Giacomo Puccini was the composer of such classic operas as "Madame Butterfly" and "La Boheme. "While he was working on another opera, which would be entitled "Turandot," Puccini contracted cancer. His friends and students begged him to slow down, saying, "You are sick; take it easy and rest." Puccini would respond, "I'm going to

do as much as I can on my great masterwork and it's up to you, my friends, to finish it if I don't." Puccini didn't. He died in November 1924.

Now his friends and students had a choice. They could mourn their friend for a while and then get on with the rest of their lives, or they could build on his melody and complete the work he started. They chose the latter. Thus, on April 25, 1926, at the famous La Scala Opera House in Milan, Italy, "Turandot" was performed for the first time, conducted by the famed conductor Arturo Toscanini.

When it came to the part of the opera where Puccini stopped composing because of his declining health, Toscanini stopped everything, turned toward the audience, and with tears in his eyes said to the crowd, "Thus far the master wrote." And he bowed his head and wept. After a few minutes, though, Toscanini raised his head, smiled broadly, and exclaimed, "But his disciples finished the work." Then he finished conducting the opera, which concluded with tremendous applause.

Thus far the priest served. We say farewell to Fr. Philipp today, appreciative that he was for us - and will be at St. Clement - a disciple finishing the work of the Master, Jesus Christ. I am grateful for his work and inspired by his zeal. His love for Jesus, his commitment to the Gospel, and his concern for you, the parishioners, has been obvious to me and, I'm sure, to you, also. Not only has Fr. Philipp's dedication enhanced the spirituality of those of us here at Queen of All Saints, but also of the students and staff at St. Mary's High. At least once a week, and sometimes more, Father has spent a day at that high school helping them grow closer to Christ.

This is the life of a parish priest, particularly an associate pastor. You work at a parish for just a while. You invest yourself in the life of the people. You pray for them, preach to them, serve them. Then you're asked to move on. You do it because you know you're not the Master, the Lord. You're just a disciple, finishing the work.

And another is sent in your place. With joy we welcome Fr. Detwiler back to Queen of All Saints. He's no longer Joe, the kid who grew up here. No, God has blessed him with the Sacrament of Holy Orders and enriched him with the title of Father. For us priests that's a beautiful, fulfilling, yet challenging title. I'm honored I have it and I'm sure Fr. Detwiler will be honored to have it, too.

May God bless Fr. Philipp as he moves and Fr. Detwiler as he arrives. May God bless all of you.





THE 12 PROMISES
WITH DEVOTIONS TO THE
MOST SACRED HEART OF
JESUS

"Behold this Heart that has loved men so much!"

A heart on fire for love of all mankind was the imagery demanded by Our Lord. The

flames bursting forth and enveloping It show the vehement love wherewith It has loved and continually loves us. The crown of thorns encircling the Heart of Jesus typifies the injury inflicted upon It by the ingratitude wherewith men requite His love. The Heart of Jesus surmounted by a cross is further testimony of Our Lord's Love for us. It reminds us particularly of His bitter Passion and Death. Devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus originated the moment when that Divine Heart was pierced by the lance, the wound remaining forever more upon His Heart. Last but not least, the rays surrounding this precious Heart signify the great graces and blessings which emanate from devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus.

"I set neither limit nor measure to My gifts of grace for those who seek them in My Heart!"

Our blessed Lord commanded that all who wish to take up the devotion to the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus go to Confession and receive Holy Communion often, especially on the First Friday of each Month. Friday is significant because it recalls Good Friday when Christ took on the passion and laid down His life for the many. If unable to make it on Friday, He called us to make a point of receiving the Holy Eucharist on Sunday, or any other day, with the intention of making reparation and render atonement and to rejoice in the Heart of our Savior. He also asked that we keep the devotion by venerating an image of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus and making prayers and sacrifices offered out of love for Him and for the conversion of sinners. Our blessed Lord then gave to St. Margaret Mary Alocoque promises for those who take up this sacred and special devotion.

So, what are the twelve promises of the Sacred Heart of Jesus and how do we obtain them? It is first important to note that the twelve promises which we find in prayer books, manuals and the list below, for the devotion to the Sacred Heart, do not contain all the promises made by our Divine Lord to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. They are not even a summary of them, but are rather a selection of those promises best calculated to arouse sentiments of love for Our Lord in the hearts of the faithful and to induce them to practice the devotion.

Jesus Made Twelve Promises to Those Who Hold a True Devotion to His Sacred Heart:

- 1. I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
- 2. I will give peace in their families and will unite families that are divided.
- 3. I will console them in all their troubles.
- 4. I will be their refuge during life and above all in death.
- 5. I will bestow the blessings of Heaven on all their enterprises.
- 6. Sinners shall find in my Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
- 7. Tepid souls shall become fervent.
- 8. Fervent souls shall rise quickly to great perfection.
- 9. I will bless those places wherein the image of My Heart shall be exposed and honored and will imprint My love on the hearts of those who would wear this image on their person. I will also destroy in them all disordered movements.
- 10. I will give to priests who are animated by a tender devotion to my Divine Heart the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
- 11. Those who promote this devotion shall have their names written in my Heart, never to be effaced.
- 12. THE GREATEST PROMISE I promise you in the excessive mercy of my Heart that my all-powerful love will grant to all those who communicate (Receive Holy Communion) on the First Friday in nine consecutive months, the grace of final penitence: they will not die in my disgrace, nor without receiving their Sacraments. My Divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

Prayer to the Sacred Heart of Jesus

O most holy heart of Jesus, fountain of every blessing.

I adore you, I love you,

and with lively sorrow for my sins I offer you this poor heart of mine.

Make me humble, patient,

pure and wholly obedient to your will.

Grant, Good Jesus, that I may live in you and for you.

Protect me in the midst of danger.

Comfort me in my afflictions.

Give me health of body,

assistance in my temporal needs, your blessing on all that I do,

and the grace of a holy death.

Amen.

QAS is seeking a Lead/Supervisor to operate the sports concession stand at the baseball-softball complex. The Lead/Supervisor will be able to coordinate the work schedule between themselves and existing management. Shifts are available Tuesday-Sunday in 4-8 hour increments. Ideally, the applicant will work one to three shifts per week, but this may vary depending on how many are hired.

The concession stand is heated and air conditioned. The stand operates during outdoor sports seasons and shifts are dependent upon the weather; if games are cancelled, then the shift is cancelled.

This is the perfect opportunity for someone who enjoys interacting with people, having friendly conversations with members of a parish community and visitors from surrounding parishes and communities.





MATTHEW 7:6, 12-14

A question that people have been asking from time immemorial is this: "Will only a few people be saved?" Heaven, hell, salvation, damnation - who will be in and who will be out?

How should we approach this issue? The doctrine concerning hell is a corollary of two more fundamental truths - namely, that God is love and that we are free. Love (willing the good of the other) is all that God is. He doesn't go in and out of love; he doesn't change his mind; he's not loving to some, and not to others. He is indeed like the sun that shines on the good and bad alike, in the words of Jesus.

However, we are also free. We are not God's marionettes, and hence we can say yes or we can say no to his love. If we turn toward it, we open like a sunflower; if we turn from it, we get burned.






VETERANS SPIRITUAL RETREAT
