

#### FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

Pope Francis says, "Receive Communion every time as if it were your first time."

Do you remember the first time you received Holy Communion? I remember some of my First Communion Day. We didn't receive Communion at the rail on that beautiful day. No, we were allowed to walk through the sanctuary gate and go two-by-two to a kneeler

right in front of the high altar. Fr. Richter, the pastor, placed the Host on my tongue. I recall going back to the pew and praying in thanksgiving, remembering not to bury my face in my hands while I prayed, as many adults did, because Sister said that wasn't "pretty." Thanksgiving and prettiness garnered my attention.

Of course, the Eucharist we celebrate in today's Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ demands more of us than prettiness. St. Thomas Aquinas put it this way: "the only-begotten Son of God offered his body to God the Father on the altar of the cross as a sacrifice for our reconciliation. Now in order that we might always keep the memory of this great act of love, Christ left us his body as food and his blood as drink." Therein lies the focus of our memory. Not the warm feelings we had at our First Communion - great as they were - but the powerful love of Jesus, a love so deep that He would offer His life so that we might experience it?

Yet, can you believe, that there are millions of people - many Catholics included - who go entire weeks without reflecting on the depth of that love? Can you believe that many Catholics will go seven straight days, or more, without celebrating the hope of that love or expressing any word of gratitude for Christ's sacrificial love? As Aquinas said, the Eucharist was left as a gift so that we might always keep alive the great memory of that love. In our times, people use apps and post-it notes to remind themselves to do certain things or be at certain places. Jesus used his own Body and Blood. Thus, in the Eucharist we are reminded of Christ's sacrifice, we are inspired by his wonderful love, and we are uplifted by promises fulfilled. No wonder we genuflect in adoration to the Blessed Sacrament.

Pray, then, for those who aren't here, for those who don't remember at least once a week what Jesus did for them, for those who bounce aimlessly along through life with no appreciation for what Jesus has done. Pray for those who expect Heaven's Gate to swing open for them even though they steadfastly refused to express any appreciation for Christ's sacrifice and victory. Pray for those who can't remember their First Holy Communion because they have dulled their minds by not receiving Communion now. Truly, they need our prayers, support, and example until all God's children gather at the Eucharistic table to share the special meal that is the Body and Blood of Christ.

As you have probably heard, Archbishop Rozanski has appointed Fr. Joseph Detwiler, the newly-ordained son of QAS, to replace Fr. Philipp. Please keep Fr. Detwiler in your prayers as he prepares to begin his assignment at the end of June.

May God bless all of you.

# DYNAMIC CATHOLIC, ALIVE! — The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi)



The Solemnity of Corpus Christi is celebrated on the first Sunday after the Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity. This feast began with St. Juliana, a young Belgian nun in the thirteenth century, who received in prayer an inspiration for a feast that would celebrate and promote the gift of the Real Presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist. This feast would eventually spread throughout the province, continent, and world. Corpus Christi and its accompanying procession with the Blessed Sacrament, celebrating the sacrament and signifying God's presence in our world and in our lives and reminding us of our common pilgrimage to Heaven, is a prayerful and edifying act of the entire Church. As a general rule, devotions are not mentioned in the Code of Canon Law. However, because of the importance of this devotion in the life of the Church, canon 944 mentions it: "When it can be done in the judgment of the diocesan bishop, as a public witness of the veneration toward the Most Holy Eucharist, a procession is to be conducted through the public streets, especially on the solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ." On this feast we can express our gratitude for the opportunity to receive our Lord every Sunday in the Eucharist, to adore Him in prayer, and to show Him to the rest of the world in the streets of our archdiocese.




