If you give someone something, do you expect something in return? Do you give your time freely or do you "fit it in" when it's convenient for you? God desires a personal relationship with us so much that He gave us His Son, unconditionally! Pray for a grateful and generous heart.

FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

The teacher was talking to her class about God and how hard it is to know about God. "Where is God?" the teacher asked. "I know where God is" called out one little boy, "He's in the bathroom."

"In the bathroom?" questioned the befuddled teacher.

"Yes, every morning my dad goes to the bathroom door and he yells, "My God, are you still in there?""

Children have a humorous, yet sometimes insightful, way of thinking of God. Consider the example of the child who wrote to God using these words: "Dear God, I didn't think orange went with purple until I saw the sunset you made Tuesday evening. That was cool."

It is "cool" to celebrate today the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity. Taking a cue from the younger members of our Faith, we seize on the opportunity to open our eyes wide in amazement at what God has done, and still does each day. Every sunrise and sunset, every gentle breeze or cool drink of water, reminds us of the splendor and beauty of what God has made. It's really cool.

But this Feast challenges us to go beyond what our eyes can see or our lips taste. We peer into the depth of God as we ponder God's mystery. We try to grasp that mystery as we read the Scripture or contemplate the writings of various theologians. With St. Paul we accept "the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit" without quite knowing how that all works. We admire God the Father as Creator, God the Son as Redeemer, and God the Holy Spirit as Sanctifier. And after doing so, we admit that a library full of books will not explain adequately the Holy Trinity.

Jesuit Father Karl Rahner was one of the great theologians of the 20th century. Toward the end of his life in 1984 he was questioned by an interviewer as to why he believed in God despite so many intellectual difficulties encountered by faith. The reporter was adamant that Fr. Rahner give a detailed theological answer, which irritated the old priest. Finally, Father declared, "Listen, I don't believe in God because I have worked everything out to the satisfaction of my mind. I continue to believe in God because I pray every day."

So it is for us, too. We can't explain this mystery. We can't define every theological doctrine. But we can converse with the Almighty daily, in fact, several times a day. We talk about world events, like a pandemic. We ask for healing, or peace in our cities, or for an end of any kind of "ism" that tears us apart. We pray for people important to us and we mention things to God that may seem silly to others, but they're not silly to us - or God. We come together on Trinity Sunday because we know God really cares for us and loves us very much. We may not be able to wax profoundly on the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, but, by gosh, we can talk to God every day, and every day God reveals His glory to us in many beautiful ways. That's pretty cool!

Our attendance at last Sunday's Masses increased from 320 on May 23/24 to 422 on May 30/31. It's good to see more gathering for the Eucharistic meal. Hopefully, more will be present this weekend. However, don't force it. If you're apprehensive at all about returning, please stay home. The dispensation granted by Archbishop Carlson is still in effect.

May God bless all of you.

PLEASE NOTE

Due to the pandemic, the Archdiocesan Office has started offering a Zoom Live Session of the original, mandatory Protecting God's Children Workshop to first time people while the stay-at-home and social distancing orders are in place. They will continue to add Zoom classes as needed. This is yet another reason to register now in the new system, **Prevent and Protect STL, while you may have some time on your hands. If you need assistance, feel free to call me at home at 314-221-3352 or email me at schroederj@qasstl.org.**

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called **Prevent and Protect STL**. **EVERYONE** (clergy, employees, and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system **ASAP**. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. However, in addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please read all instructions before beginning. Please allow about 1 hour of your time to complete **ALL** modules. (You may log in and out at your convenience, if desired.)

Once some of these restrictions are lifted we will resume Adoration.

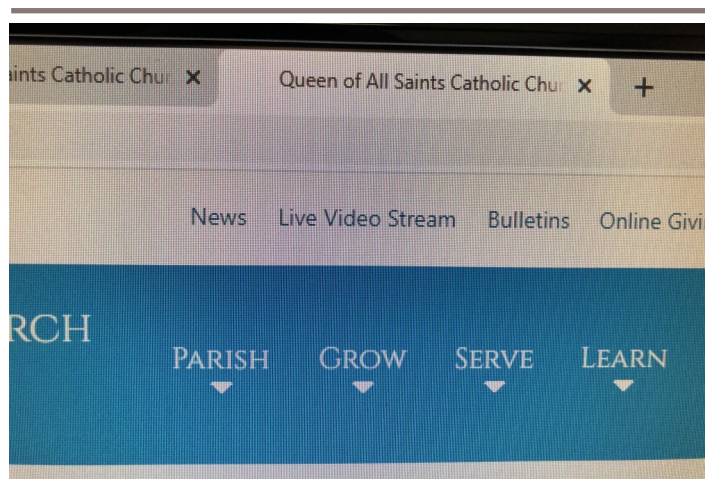

DYNAMIC CATHOLIC, *ALIVE!* - MOST HOLY TRINITY - THE TRIUNE GOD

I have often heard priests tell me that this solemnity is one of the most difficult days in the liturgical year on which to preach a good homily. It is difficult to preach a homily on such a central mystery of our faith like the Trinity. What is essential to remember for all Catholics is to simply listen to the readings and each of the prayers today for the Mass. Within these texts we can find spiritual insights today for the Mass. For example, the preface for the Mass today provides a great summary of the Church's teaching on the mystery of the Trinity: "For what you have revealed to us of your glory we believe equally of your Son and of the Holy Spirit, so that, in the confessing of the true and eternal Godhead, you might be adored in what is proper to each Person, their unity in substance, and their equality in majesty." One God in three Persons is always there for us.

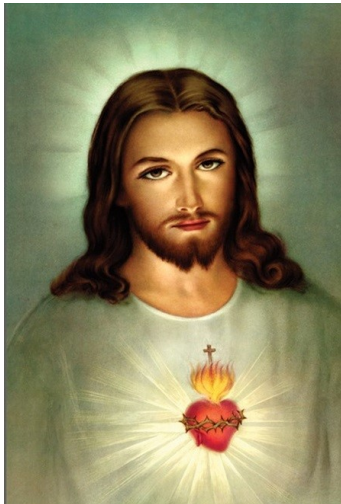

The Sacred Heart of Jesus is a powerful symbol of Christ's unquenchable love for the whole human race.

THE 12 PROMISES OF THE SACRED HEART OF JESUS TO ST. MARGARET MARY ALACOQUE

Our Lord Jesus Christ appeared to [St. Margaret Mary](#) between 1673-1675. Among the words spoken to her, she heard Jesus make 12 promises to those who would respond to the pleading of His Heart and make an effort to return His love.

1. I will give them all the graces necessary in their state of life.
2. I will establish peace in their homes.
3. I will comfort them in all their afflictions.
4. I will be their secure refuge during life, and above all, in death.
5. I will bestow abundant blessings upon all their undertakings.
6. Sinners will find in My Heart the source and infinite ocean of mercy.
7. Lukewarm souls shall become fervent.
8. Fervent souls shall quickly mount to high perfection.
9. I will bless every place in which an image of My Heart is exposed and honored.
10. I will give to priests the gift of touching the most hardened hearts.
11. Those who shall promote this devotion shall have their names written in My Heart.
12. I promise you in the excessive mercy of My Heart that My all powerful love will grant to all those who receive Holy Communion on the First Fridays in nine consecutive months the grace of final perseverance; they shall not die in My disgrace, nor without receiving their sacraments. My divine Heart shall be their safe refuge in this last moment.

**ACT OF CONSECRATION TO THE
SACRED HEART**

O Sacred Heart of Jesus I consecrate and offer up my person and my life, my actions, trials, and sufferings, that my entire being may henceforth only be employed in loving, honoring and glorifying Thee. This is my irrevocable will, to belong entirely to Thee, and to do all for Thy love, renouncing with my whole heart all that can displease Thee.

I take Thee, O Sacred Heart, for the sole object of my love, the protection of my life, the pledge of my salvation, the remedy of my frailty and inconstancy, the reparation for all the defects of my life, and my secure refuge at the hour of my death. Be Thou, O Most Merciful Heart, my justification before God Thy Father, and screen me from His anger which I have so justly merited. I fear all from my own weakness and malice, but placing my entire confidence in Thee, O Heart of Love, I hope all from Thine infinite Goodness. Annihilate in me all that can displease or resist Thee. Imprint Thy pure love so deeply in my heart that I may never forget Thee or be separated from Thee.

I beseech Thee, through Thine infinite Goodness, grant that my name be engraved upon Thy Heart, for in this I place all my happiness and all my glory, to live and to die as one of Thy devoted servants.
