Putting our trust in God, in everything we do, in good times and in bad, means that God's plan for our lives may be quite different than what we planned. When one door closes, another one opens. Trust in God, His plan is always better.

FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

An eight year-old boy approached the elderly man in front of a wishing well, looked up to his eyes, and said, "I understand you're a very wise man. I'd like to know the secret of life."

The old man looked down with kindness and replied, "I've thought about that a lot in my lifetime and I think the secret of life can be summed up in four words.

"The first is Think. Think about the values by which you wish to live your life.

"The second is Believe. Believe in yourself based on the thinking you've done about those values by which you're going to live your life.

"The third is Dream. Dream about the things that can be, based on your belief in yourself and the values by which you/re going to live your life.

"The last is Dare. Dare to make your dreams become reality, based on your belief in yourself and your values."

Thus was the advice given to a young boy by a guy named Walt Disney - Think, Believe, Dream and Dare.

I'm sure Jesus would agree with Walt Disney, especially with the necessity of concentrated focus that lies beneath the surface of the elderly man's advice. Christ in today's Gospel holds up as praiseworthy the one who is willing to search diligently for the buried treasure or the fine pearl. Follow the example of this one, Jesus would say, who dreams of something special and dares to sell every possession in order to grasp that dream. The Kingdom of Heaven is that important to disciples of Jesus Christ.

Today's Gospel concludes a section in St. Matthew's Gospel wherein Jesus has been using parables to teach about the Kingdom of God, parables that we've heard the past two Sundays, along with today. The Kingdom is like seed scattered by the sower: the seed brings forth a harvest thirty or sixty or a hundredfold; the seed brings forth good wheat which will persevere among the weeds; the small seed grows into the largest of bushes. Today we learn that the Kingdom is better than the largest of treasures or the finest of pearls. Jesus is doing his best to hammer home the importance of the Kingdom of Heaven.

When finished - as today's Gospel records - Jesus asked a simple question, "Do you understand all these things?" The disciples answered that they did understand. Do we? May our actions and words give evidence that we have said "yes" to the question of Jesus. May we inform the world by our faith that we know the secret of life, and it's the Kingdom of Heaven, about which we are willing to Think, Believe. Dream and Dare.

The greatest treasure we can have on earth is the Body and Blood of Christ. As it was last weekend, so it is today our privilege to witness our younger parishioners receive their First Holy Communion. May God bestow his goodness and love to them through this Blessed Sacrament. May these First Communicants - and each one of us - always cherish the wonderful gift of the Eucharist.

The **St. Louis Review** and **Catholic St. Louis** received a combined 13 awards from the Catholic Press Association, announced July 2 at a virtual awards ceremony. The annual Catholic Media Conference, to be held this year in Portland, Oregon, was cancelled because of the coronavirus pandemic.

The St. Louis Review received first place **newspaper of the year** for weekly diocesan newspapers with circulation over 25,000, the highest honor for newspapers in that category. GREAT TIME TO REGISTER FOR PREVENT AND PROTECT STL

NEW SAFE ENVIRONMENT REQUIREMENTS AT NO COST TO YOU!

PLEASE NOTE

Due to the pandemic, the Archdiocesan Office has started offering a Zoom Live Session of the original, mandatory Protecting God's Children Workshop to first time people while the stay-athome and social distancing orders are in place. They will continue to add Zoom classes as needed. This is yet another reason to register now in the new system, Prevent and Protect STL, while you may have some time on your hands. If you need assistance, feel free to call me at home at 314-221-3352 or email me at schroederj@qasstl.org.

The Archdiocese of St. Louis has developed a new system for safe environment compliance called Prevent and Protect STL. EVERYONE (clergy, employees, and volunteers) ministering to minors and vulnerable adults in the Archdiocese are required and asked to register in the new system **ASAP**. This includes those new to service and those who are currently in service. For those who have already attended a Protecting God's Children workshop, your previous training date will transfer to this new system. However, in addition to attending a live Protecting God's Children workshop, all clergy, volunteers, and employees will register for an updated background screening, view two new online training modules on abuse reporting and the Code of Ethical Conduct, and agree to the updated Code of Ethical Conduct. Please read all instructions before beginning. Please allow about 1 hour of your time to complete ALL modules. (You may log in and out at your convenience, if desired.)
