The Congregation was founded in 1933 by the Missionaries of Africa. It was established in response to the tremendous social, economic, and spiritual needs of the people. The Sisters

focus their ministry on love and service, living their lives in prayer and ministry by engaging in different activities, such as health care, pastoral ministry, social work, education, and women and youth development. Their education and healthcare ministry are particularly directed to rural areas of Tanzania where service to poor, nomadic people, orphans, and deaf children are very much needed.


Sr. Veronica Boniface entered the Congregation of the Daughters of Mary in 1986 and made Final Vows in 1998. She was sent to study in the United States in 2010 and received a Bachelor degree in education from the College of St. Mary in Nebraska and a master's degree from Seton Hall University in New Jersey. 



You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, you will need your User name and Password. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.


