Dear Parishioners,

We welcome to Queen of All Saints Sr. Veronica Boniface, a member of the Congregation of the Daughters of Mary, headquartered in the Archdiocese of Tabora, Tanzania. The Congregation was founded in 1933 by the Missionaries of Africa. It was established in response to the tremendous social, economic, and spiritual needs of the people. The Sisters focus their ministry on love and service, living their lives in prayer and ministry by engaging in different activities, such as health care, pastoral ministry, social work, education, and women and youth development. Their education and healthcare ministry are particularly directed to rural areas of Tanzania where service to poor, nomadic people, orphans, and deaf children are very much needed.

Sr. Veronica Boniface entered the Congregation of the Daughters of Mary in 1986 and made Final Vows in 1998. She was sent to study in the United States in 2010 and received a Bachelor degree in education from the College of St. Mary in Nebraska and a master's degree from Seton Hall University in New Jersey. Currently, Sister is participating in an Internship program in Omaha. Please welcome her to Queen of All Saints and be generous in your response to her words.

Pope Benedict XVI said, "A good school provides a rounded education for the whole person. And a good Catholic school, over and above this, should help all its students to become saints." On Wednesday, Queen of All Saints School will commence again with its mission to put its students on the road to sainthood. The new principal, Mrs. Beumer, will head.
