FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

Fred Spencer wrote a popular book named <u>The Jungle Is Neutral</u>. Spencer had been a soldier in World War II, stationed in a small garrison on the island of Singapore, just off the tip of the Malay Peninsula. The British defense of the garrison was rather one-sided as they felt that no army could ever pass through the impenetrable jungles to the north, and that any attack on Singapore would have to come from the sea.

Wrong! To the chagrin of the British, however, the Japanese did the seemingly impossible and passed through the thick jungles of the Peninsula to attack the garrison. Singapore fell almost without a fight.

Fred Spencer, though, was able to escape into the jungle, and he spent nine months there before he was able to rejoin his countrymen.

He had heard two conflicting reports about the jungle, but at the time of his escape he had had very little time to prepare to meet the jungle's challenges. He had heard that it was a horrible place filled with snakes and insects, fruit so poisonous that one bite could kill a man, and brutal wild animals. Therefore, any person lost in the harsh forests would die very quickly. But the other story Spencer had been told was that the jungle was a lush, tropical paradise with plenty of fresh water and edible fruit. In other words, it was a place where anyone could survive with relative ease.

The truth that Spencer discovered during his nine months in the jungle was that the jungle was neutral. Spencer found the jungle was neither pre-set to destroy him by making it impossible to survive, nor was it structured to support him. He learned that his survival depended directly on the amount of effort he put forth to survive. Spencer was able to make of his environment what he chose to make. After all, the jungle is neutral.

So is the law. Our readings today give insight into the choices we make concerning the Law. In the First Reading from the Book of Deuteronomy, Moses includes in his farewell address encouragement to obey the Law, the statutes and decrees not created by a vote or by the deliberations of a legislative body, but handed down by God Himself. Give evidence, Moses implores, of your wisdom and intelligence, by observing the Commandments. Let everyone know what a great nation you are, whose God is very close to it. Faithfulness to the Law leads to greatness and God will be there whenever God is called upon.

Moses offers a strategy concerning the Law quite different from the Pharisees whom Jesus criticizes in the gospel. These people have taken the Law and used it to clobber the faithful. The Law no longer allows people to give evidence of wisdom and intelligence. Now it's just a burden they must carry, routines they must endure.

God gave the Law that it might be embraced, cherished, and obeyed. Jesus came not to erase the Law but to perfect it. There is tremendous potential for good in the Law. But also for bad. The Pharisees and scribes gathered around Jesus prove that. Their nitpicking obscures the beauty of the Law.

It sits there for us, this Law, these Commandments, the teachings of Jesus Christ and His Church. We can ignore all this, disobey when we feel like, or put forth an arrogance that says we can figure all things by themselves, we don't need any help. Such an attitude, I believe, leads to destruction. Or, we can be thrilled that such guidance is available to us. We can use this guidance to grow closer to Christ, to walk more steadily with Christ toward the Kingdom, and give evidence to all that we are a wise and intelligent people.

I want to thank Tim Buback for his service to Queen of All Saints. These past few years Tim has served as Youth Minister for our parish. With enthusiasm and creativity, he has brought our youth together and pointed them in a direction of Jesus Christ by way of weekly meetings, prayer, and retreats. I appreciate very much all he has done. Please pray for him as he accepts a position in the business world. And pray for Tim's successor, Anna Hackett, and for all our youth, as they continue their journey of faith together.




