FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Perhaps you've heard the story of the two brothers who inherited the family farm. One brother had married and with his wife was raising a large family, the other brother remained single. At the day's end, the brothers shared everything equally, produce and profit.

Then one day the single brother said to himself, "It's not right that we should share equally the produce and the profit. I'm alone, after all, and my needs are simple." So each night he took a sack of grain from his bin and crept across the field between their houses, dumping it into his brother's bin.

Meanwhile, the married brother said to himself, "It's not right that we should share the produce and the profit equally. After all, I'm married and I have my wife and my children to look after me for years to come. My brother has no one now, and no one to take care of his future." So each night he took a sack of grain and dumped it into his bachelor brother's bin.

Both men were puzzled for years because their supply of grain never dwindled. Then one dark night the two brothers bumped into each other. Slowly it dawned on them what was happening. They dropped their sacks and embraced one another.

What a beautiful example of the message received from the Letter of St. James, "If a brother or sister has nothing to wear and has no food for the day, and one of you says to them, 'Go in peace, keep warm, and eat well,' but you do not give them the necessities of the body, what good is it? So also faith itself, if it does not have works, is dead." These two brothers were determined to make their faith more than the recitation of words. Concern for one another produced action and actions led to wonderful blessings.

Members of our St. Vincent de Paul Society have experienced the same blessings because they share the same faith - words and action. Just this morning, on the day I wrote this column, I encountered some of our SVDP members along with two representatives of the Hancock School District. All of them had just completed stuffing the car of the Hancock people with bags of food stuffed by our SVDP. These bags would be distributed to Hancock students at the end of the school week to assure that the children would have something to eat over the weekend. On school days the children receive a free breakfast and lunch. But as the week comes to a close, too many of the students worry if they will eat over the weekend. This anxiety is removed by the efforts of our St. Vincent de Paul Society. Their work coupled with your donations allows youngsters the chance to enter a weekend with the confidence of knowing they will not go hungry. They leave school on Friday happily knowing they won't have to wait until Monday morning to eat again. And the people who stuffed those bags and loaded those cars? They didn't look for acclaim. They weren't waiting for applause.

None of our SVDP members look for that, yet they continue to serve generously so many people in a variety of ministries. God bless them! It's a reason I encourage you to support the Walk for the Poor. Donate. Participate. Enjoy the Walk and the food and know that you are supporting a beautiful part of the faith manifested at Queen of All Saints, a faith which is certainly not dead, for as St. James wrote, "I will demonstrate my faith to you from my works."





**If you have previously attended a PGC workshop, the system will find and ask you to confirm your previous record of attendance. You will not be prompted to register for an upcoming workshop.

You may use the links in your approval checklist to access these requirements. These steps may be completed all at once or may be completed separately at your convenience. Please note: if you do not complete all modules and decide to finish at a later date, you will need your User name and Password. You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. When all compliance requirements have been completed, your account will be approved and you will be clear to work with minors and vulnerable adults.
