#### FROM OUR PASTOR



Dear Parishioners,

I received a letter last week from Archbishop Rozanski which read in part:

Thank you for your work on 2021 Annual Catholic Appeal. Even in the midst of the Covid pandemic the Appeal raised more than ever before. Over 38,900 households contributed more than \$15.9 million to help build the Church. (Here at Queen of All Saints 420 households contributed over \$145,000). I appreciate your help in inviting parishioners to participate more fully in the life and

mission of Jesus Christ and His Church. As you know, Queen of All Saints parishioners were very generous with the Appeal, even in the midst of the pandemic. Without their help, I would not have such good news to report.

A few days ago, I offered a bouquet of flowers to Mary with the team from the Office of Stewardship and the Annual Catholic Appeal. Please join me in thanking Our Lady for her continued intercession for the Appeal. I will keep your parish in my prayers. May God continue to pour out His blessings upon them.

I add my own thanks to that of the archbishop. The theme of this year's Appeal was Thy Will Be Done with Faith, Service and Charity. Certainly the money collected by the Appeal aid thousands of people throughout Archdiocese, Fr. Detwiler and me being two of them. Money from previous Appeals helped fund the seminary where we received our education and now it helps with opportunities for continued education and retreats. Other monies from the Appeal are directed toward our retirement, money I will use WAY before Fr. Detwiler. As members of the St. Louis Archdiocese we may be proud of the generous way so many people donate to help those in our midst in need of support.

One winter day, a little boy was standing on a grate next to a bakery, trying to keep his shoeless feet warm. A woman passing by saw the frosty-toed child and her heart ached. He had on only a lightweight jacket and no shoes, and the air was chilly, the wind sharp.

"Where are your shoes, young man?" she asked. The boy shyly said he didn't have any shoes. "Why don't you come with me and we'll see what we can do about that?" Taking his hand, she led him into a nearby department store (remember those?) and bought him a new pair of shoes and a warm jacket.

When they came back onto the street, the little boy was so excited that he immediately started to run off to show his family his gifts. Suddenly he halted, turned around and ran back to the woman. He thanked her and then hesitated, "Ma'am, could I ask you a question? Ma'am, are you God's wife?"

The woman smiled and said, "Oh, no, I'm not God's wife. I'm just one of His children."

The little boy grinned and exclaimed enthusiastically, "I knew it. I just knew you were related."

The Annual Catholic Appeal is one way we prove we are related to God. Our own St. Vincent de Paul Walk for the Poor is another. The many ministries we have at our parish and/or the various other charities with which you may be involved also give evidence of our closeness to Jesus Christ, the One who came to serve us all.

At the point of their lives where today's Gospel takes place, the Twelve are having a hard time understanding the demands of charity and service. They're too busy arguing amongst themselves about which one of them is the greatest. Jesus has to teach them a tough lesson.

Our opportunities to help others remain a blessing to us. Through them we realize the veracity of the words of Jesus: "Whoever receives one child such as this in my name, receives me; and whoever receives me, receives not me but the One who sent me."


#### MARTHAS FUNERAL LUNCH MINISTRY

Blood is amazing stuff. Did you know that adults have approximately 16 pints of blood in their body at any given time? One collection unit of blood is about 1 pint. It takes roughly 14 hours for your body to replace a donated pint of blood. In the U.S. alone, 41,000 units of blood are used each day. Only about 5% of healthy Americans donate blood. Multiple donations account for over 80% of the blood used for transfusions.

#### There is no substitute for blood.

You have the power to help people you may not even know. All is takes is for you to roll up your sleeve and donate a pint of blood. Remember, whole blood and blood products such as platelets can't be manufactured; they can only be given freely through the compassionate generosity of donors.

If you are at least 17 year's old, weigh at least 110 pounds and are in general good health, please give the gift of life!


