#### STEWARDSHIP TWENTY-SIXTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

"No servant can serve two masters. He will hate one and love the other, or be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and mammon (wealth)."

LUKE 16:13

Jesus knows that for many of us, God and money run "neck and neck" as top priority. Is money a "god" that you put before God? Giving money to support the Church and other charities is a pillar of our faith, just like attending Mass every Sunday and participating in parish ministry. Giving money frees us from becoming a slave to money. It increases our dependence on God and our trust that God will provide all that we need.

#### FROM OUR PASTOR

Dear Parishioners,

Also, Mass will not be offered at any time from Tuesday, October 4th until Friday, October 7th, inclusive. Both priests will be away attending the Quadrennial Convocation of Priests in the Ozarks.

Joe Waddick is the Grand Marshall for today's St. Vincent de Paul Society's Walk For the Poor, and a great choice for such an honor is he. Joe, I believe, was one of the founding members of our St. Vincent de Paul Society and, if not the first, one of its first presidents. He has devoted decades of his life to helping the poor, backed up, I'm sure, by his wife, Barb. It was not unusual for me to walk into the parish office and find Joe there collecting grocery gift cards to take to the home of one struggling with finances. Joe was on his way to help, even though he was over 90 years old. Still young enough to imitate Jesus Christ, who came to serve.

I don't know how far Joe will walk today in his role as Grand Marshall, but I do know that those who walk behind him will be walking along Christopher, Schnell, and Cripple Creek, and not into exile.

The people mentioned in today's First Reading from the Book of the Prophet Amos; they were the ones being sent into exile, and, unlucky them, they got to go first! That's what happens, we are told, when all you want to do is stretch comfortably upon your couch, eat the best of food, and play with your harp as if you had some kind of musical talent. "The poor? The hungry? The widow or orphan? Who cares. Hey, listen to this song I made up."

Unlucky them. They get to go on a walk. They get to go first. But it's not a walk to raise money to help the poor. And it's not a walk followed by a time of good food and fellowship. No, it's a walk into exile, followed by years of suffering and hardship.

So, today many will don their white t-shirts (not purple, like the clothes worn by the selfish guy in today's Gospel) and proceed step-by-step to help those who need our help. Here is one more opportunity, one more time, when our St. Vincent de Paul Society and many other parishioners heed the call of Christ to serve one another. May God bless those on the walk today.

We can be glad, too, that so many parishioners participated in the 2022 Annual Catholic Appeal. This year's Appeal raised more money than ever before—\$16.8 million. People from our parish contributed \$158,355 toward that goal. That's a splendid total, though we did fall a bit short of our goal of \$173,000. Nevertheless, over 400 parishioners made a commitment to not only help the poor and hungry, but also other people in need, like our seminarians and retired priests. The Annual Catholic Appeal allows us as a parish to cooperate with an effort bigger than ourselves and show the entire St. Louis area how much we Catholics care about one another. I'm grateful to all of you who participated, and for David Little and Kathy Schmidt and their helpers for all the work they did on the Appeal. You're great!

See as Christians we can't stretch comfortably, eat sumptuously, and stroll about in the finest of clothes while simultaneously ignoring the poor. That's not our calling. One of the greatest opera singers of the nineteenth century was a Swede named Jenny Lind, called "The Swedish Nightingale." Her voice electrified crowds all over Europe. One time when she sang in London, Queen Victoria went to all sixteen of her performances. When she toured the United States in 1850-1851, she earned the equivalence of \$11 million. Tickets were so valuable they weren't sold, they were auctioned. Yet, despite such fame, Jenny retired in her early thirties.

Many wondered why. Why give up such fame and fortune? One day a friend found her on the beach, her bible on her knees, a glorious sunset in her sight. As they talked, the friend just had to ask, "Jenny, why did you abandon the stage at the height of your success?"

Jenny answered quietly, "when every day it made me think less of this (laying a finger on her bible) and nothing at all of that (pointing to the sunset), what else could I do?"

What else can we do? We who have been so blessed, we who have so much. What else can we do but join and/or contribute to the Walk For the Poor?
