Dear Parishioners,

Author Stephen King wrote, "Amateurs wait for inspiration. The rest of us just get up and go to work." Labor Day weekend gives us the opportunity to thank God for the blessings we have received through our work and prompts us to pray for those who struggle to find gainful employment. While there are jobs aplenty out there, many of them are not the type

of work for which people have been trained or educated. Let us pray that soon all people may be able to use their abilities and skills and find jobs which will allow them to provide for their families and contribute to the good of society.


The Gospel today tells us about some people who didn't wait inspiration, they just god up and took their deaf friend to Jesus from there the Lord too over. Looking up to heaven for strength and touching the man as a sign of compassion, Jesus commands that the man's ears be opened and the voice be perfected. Immediately the cure happens and the praise begins. Jesus is no amateur. He just goes to work, and when he does, blessings flow from heaven.

Some of you are retired from the working world. Some of you still rise five or more days a week to put in an honest day's work. Some of you have not yet started your careers. But all of us have been called by Christ to labor in his vineyard and produce good fruit, fruit that is pleasing to God and beneficial to God's people. My hope is that your work and mine is top-notch, the highest of quality, a masterpiece for the Lord. May that be our ambition, for as Ralph Waldo Emerson said long ago, "Without ambition one starts nothing. Without work one finishes nothing. The prize will not be sent to you. You have to win it.

Elsewhere in this bulletin you will find the prayer offered at Ground Zero in New York by Pope Benedict XVI in 2008 and again by Pope Francis in 2015. Any of us born before 1995 vividly remembers the horrors of twenty years ago, September 11, 2001. What a shocking day - a day of terror, loss, mourning, and prayer, lots of prayers. Like me, perhaps you will be watching various shows or documentaries this week about that fateful day. In watching such shows, I find myself intrigued by the power of the human spirit (a spirit, I believe, animated by God), saddened that some people could inflict such tragedy on other people, uplifted by so many who performed such acts of heroism, and compelled to cry out to God in prayer. "O Lord," I will say, "turn our hearts from dreadful evil. Turn our hearts to Christ, your Son." This prayer I will offer while reflecting on the evil revealed in 2001 while simultaneously pleading with God to halt the evils still among us in 2021. I encourage you to do the same, especially using the prayer of the popes on Saturday, the twentieth anniversary of that terrible day.





Baskets on the tables near the 3 entrances of Church are designated for the special collection for Haiti.



You will receive an automated email weekly to remind you which requirements are outstanding. 
