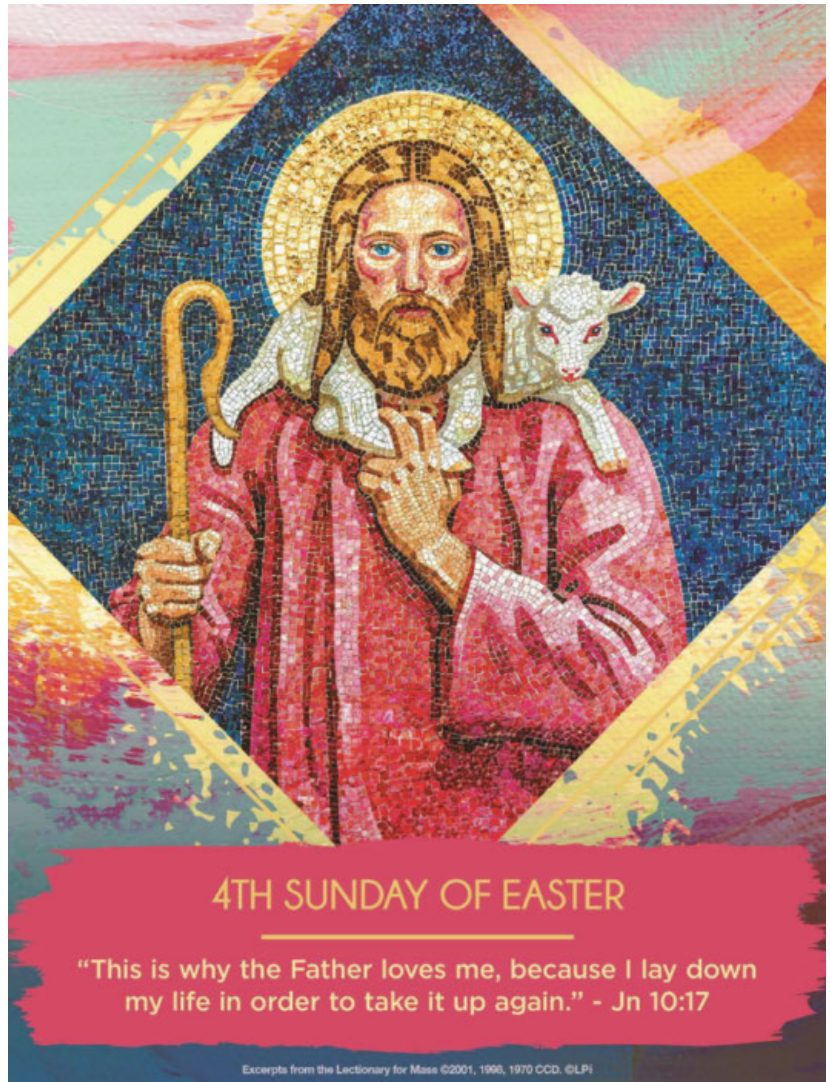

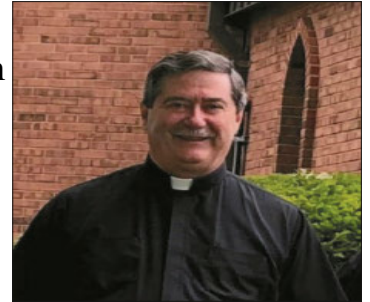
“I am the good shepherd...and I lay down my life for the sheep...and they will heed my voice.”



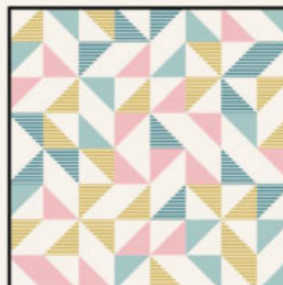
