

Meals bring us together to celebrate important moments in our lives, even moments that are sad. Our Marthas Funeral Lunch Ministry helps families who are mourning by providing food for a meal so that they have one less thing to worry about in their time of loss.

We are looking for volunteers to help cook meals for funeral luncheons. It's not very difficult. Usually all you need to do is cook "Catholic" food such as a mostaccioli, casseroles, potato salad, string beans (with the brown crunchy stuff on top) a desert, olives....etc. (Non-Catholic food such as Alaskan King Crab and/or Filet Mignon are also welcome!) 




Holy Hour for Priestly and Religious Vocations

Each Thursday we meet with the intention of building closer friendships and growing closer to the Lord through our friends. We spend time in prayer as well as time hanging out and growing in faith.




