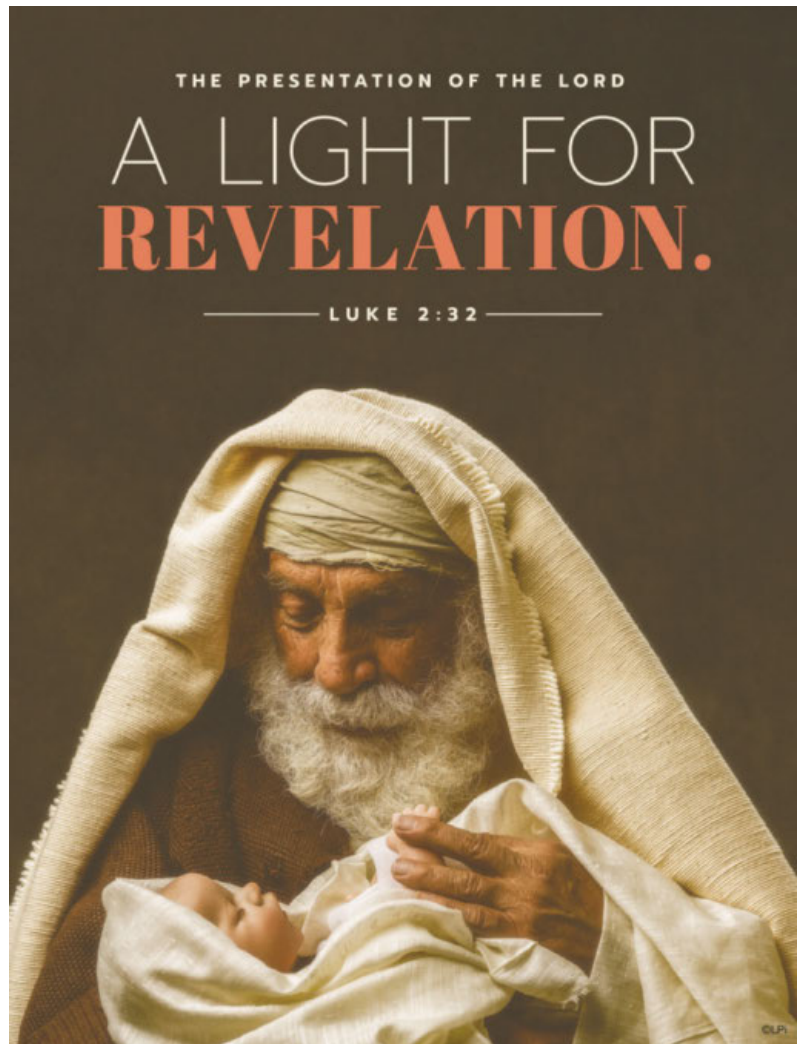

Meals bring us together to celebrate important moments in our lives, even moments that are sad. Our Marthas Funeral Lunch Ministry helps families who are mourning by providing food for a meal so that they have one less thing to worry about in their time of loss.

We are looking for volunteers to help cook meals for funeral luncheons. It's not very difficult. Usually all you need to do is cook "Catholic" food such as a mostaccioli, casseroles, potato salad, string beans (with the brown crunchy stuff on top) a desert, olives....etc. (Non-Catholic food such as Alaskan King Crab and/or Filet Mignon are also welcome!) Maybe you have a specialty, a family favorite that you can share (I'm looking at you, Fr D'Amico with your lasagna recipe).

We also are looking for volunteers who have the time to set up and serve these meals in the church basement after a funeral.
