A couple of weeks ago, in my pastor’s column, I asked for help paying for the cost overrun of our new pews. There has been a very generous response to this request from our parishioners. The Knights of Columbus responded with a \$15,000 contribution for the pews and several parishioners have also made some very generous contributions. I am very grateful for the gifts that have been given. We are scheduled to begin the renovation project following the Masses on Sunday June 9th. Subsequent Sunday Masses will be held in the school cafeteria until the project is completed; hopefully in mid-August before school begins. Weekday masses will be celebrated in the church hall, but these plans could change as we get closer to the start date. St Francis of Assisi Parish has graciously agreed to let us celebrate funerals in their church during this time. Once again, thank you to all of you who have contributed to this project. ANNUAL CATHOLIC APPEAL

The Annual Catholic Appeal will begin this weekend with the presentation of the ACA Video at all Masses. We are asked by God to share a portion of our blessings with those who struggle in life. Many of us do not have the time, opportunity nor capability of serving the poor on the “front lines”. It would be difficult for many of us to serve in the food pantries, homeless shelters, homes for battered and abused women and children or to work with immigrants that find their way into our city, and children who are disadvantaged in our schools....etc. Even though we might not be able to directly serve the poor in these situations we can support those who do serve on the front lines, who have the training, time and capability to make a difference in the lives of our brothers and sisters who need help. Christians have always been asked to tithe a portion of their blessings to charity. Traditionally, we are asked to give 10% of our gross income to charitable causes. Catholics are asked to give 5% to their local parish and 5% to a charity or a cause of their choice. The Annual Catholic Appeal is the most important collection we have as Catholics. We might not be able to do much as individuals, but as a collective group, as the Body of Christ, we have incredible power and capability to allow Jesus to continue His saving work in this world through us. You might have already received your contribution card in the mail, but if not, they will be available after Masses today and for the next two weeks. If you are not a parishioner or cannot find your contribution card, blank cards are available.

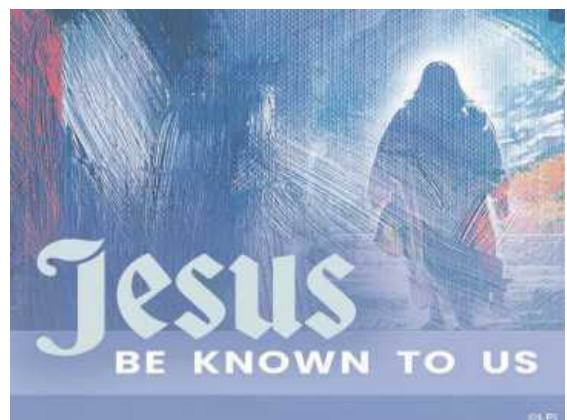

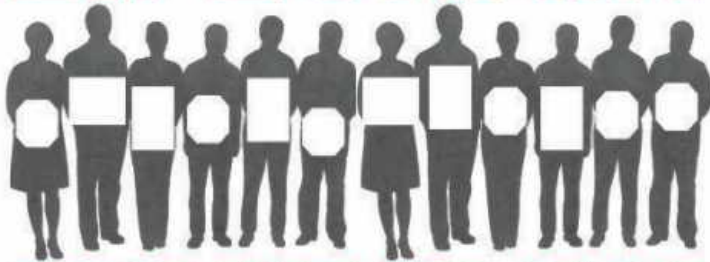
